

# Git Notes

Specify the private SSH-key to use when executing a Git command:

```
ssh-agent bash -c 'ssh-add /home/git/.ssh/key-filename; git $GIT_COMMAND'
```

Example:

```
ssh-agent bash -c 'ssh-add /home/git/.ssh/key-filename; git push'
```
